This ministry is held once a month in the Family Life Center. It is for kids crawling through Grade 5. Cost is a minimal between \$5 and \$10 per child. Pizza, snacks, soda and movie will be shown while you enjoy your PNO. We ask that all PCBC member participants, join a rotation of keeping the kids. This is usually about once every 3 to 6 months. Kids not walking are asked to bring a walker and/or play pen. Each child needs a blanket and pillow.

Parent's Night Out Agenda

On **Thursday**: pick up key to FLC from Church office by 4:30PM. Call the office before pick up of key. If key is not available, someone will be there to unlock for you at the time of PNO.

On **Friday**: Prior to arriving at Church: pick up movie, pizza, drinks and chips. Keep your receipt! Don't forget plates, cups and napkins. Movie should not include any witchcraft, language, or violence. A rating of "G" is preferred, but some "PG" movies are OK. Always make sure the parents are aware of the movie being shown.

There is a gray plastic box located in the FLC Kitchen and labeled Parents Morning Out and Parents Night Out. This box contains some miscellaneous supplies such as toys, cards that the kids can write to folks, movies and cd's. It also contains the notebook with needed forms and information.

Friday:

6:00PM: Kids arrive at the FLC.

Make sure you have a signed permission slip for each child.

Collect money {Fees are based on your expense, plus the money for teen sitter[s] divided by the number of kids in attendance) —reimburse yourself from the monies collected, pay the teenage sitters \$20 each. Any monies left over should be placed in an offering envelope and labeled "Parent's Night Out"—and given to Ms. Kim on Sunday.

Place coats, diaper bags, supplies, etc in the FLC hallway.

Check bathrooms—running water, lights off

Lights off—kitchen, equipment room

Doors locked—back, kitchen, front

9:45PM: Play game with group

Heads Up Seven Up, Red light Green light, Bible Duck Duck Goose, etc.

10:00PM: Parent pick up

10:15PM: Lock all doors

Cut all lights off

Bring the key back to the office on **Monday** between the hours of 8:30AM – 4:30PM
